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		<p>of other potential consortiums.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Jamie said that one of the best things to come out of AYIP is the sharing of best practice between each organisation and/or service</li> <li>- RM stated that case management is a crucial part of AYIP, as young people often do not have parents, role models and/or significant adults in their lives, and as such sharing resources and staff allows AYIP to have a consistent approach to ensuring that there is one-on-one engagement with young people that need extra support, and therefore, greater opportunity for positive development</li> </ul>		
3.	<b>Update on the Regional Youth CAN Action Plan</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• AT gave a brief update on the progress of the Regional Youth CAN Action Plan. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- AT explained that there have been changes to the layout of the Action Plan, as the other CANs have begun the process of prioritising the Focus Areas that they would like to progress moving forward.</li> <li>- AT stated that since the Armadale Youth CAN has been working on developing their priority Focus Areas further for quite some time, there is a significant amount of information on the Action Plan for the group.
