Once a child gets sent to youth detention in WA, there's a 50% chance they'll end up back in jail within two years.

One program trying to tackle this issue is Save the Children's - Youth Partnership Project.

The project's manager Karina Chicote told Drive after six years of work the team is achieving results but faces an uncertain future when funding runs out mid-year.
